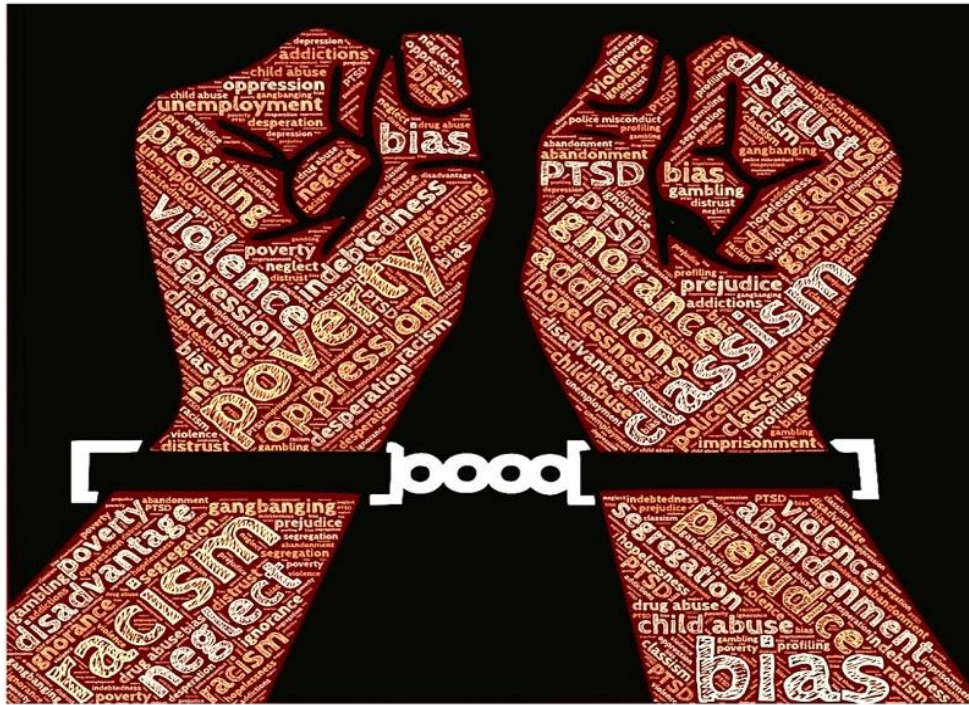


Racism in America
