

GUIDELINES for ENGAGEMENT of SUPPLY CLERGY
from a **NEIGHBORING DIOCESE** within **PROVINCE ONE**

*The Episcopal dioceses in New England: Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont,
Western Massachusetts, Massachusetts, Connecticut, and Rhode Island*

Clergy canonically resident in any diocese of Province One may be engaged by congregations within another diocese for supply clergy services, under the following conditions:

- **Licensing:** A priest who is to serve supply more than 3 consecutive Sundays in one congregation, OR more than 8 Sundays total within a calendar year in a neighboring diocese, must seek formal License to Serve in that neighboring diocese.
- **Access:** Access to Clergy Supply Lists is handled in differing ways by the dioceses. Congregations should contact the respective Bishop's Office for information on how to obtain the most recent Supply List.
- **Honoraria:** Honorarium rates and mileage policies of the dioceses vary. Current rates should be obtained from the pertinent diocese. The rates of the congregation being served will prevail, unless otherwise negotiated.

Lists are to be kept current by the dioceses, reflecting only clergy in good standing who are currently active in providing supply services. Annotations regarding geographical and/or seasonal availability are encouraged.
