Courses Required for All Individuals (9 courses)

Set 1: Universal Training (approximately 1 hours and 40 minutes total)

Scroll down to the section titled “Browse” then click on the down arrow for Program/Role and click on the Safe Church, Safe Communities Universal (8) line (picture below with the Green Arrow).

Set 2: Specialty Training (approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes total)

Scroll down to the section titled “Browse” then click on the down arrow for Program/Role and click on the Safe Church, Safe Communities Specialty (8) line (picture below with the Blue Arrow).

- Safe Church, Safe Communities: Pastoral Relationships (30 minutes)
- Safe Church, Safe Communities: Bullying (20 minutes)
- Safe Church, Safe Communities: Abuse and Neglect (20 minutes)

Additional Course Required for All

Scroll down to the section titled “Browse” and type “Mandated” into the box with the magnifying glass and press return/enter. This will bring up the 3 languages of the Duty to Report course.

- Duty to Report: Mandated Reporter (30 minutes)
